








The Drassanes Reials, or Royal Dockyards, which house the Museu Marítim de Barcelona (MMB), are one of the most significant buildings associated with the city's maritime history and culture, and have been designated a Cultural Site of National Interest. They are an outstanding architectural landmark situated in the historic centre of Barcelona with several unique and versatile spaces which can be used for many different kinds of events.






1_ Sala Gran

This recently-restored, 1,700 m² hall is 300 years old, and with its columns rising up to support the roof, is one of the most characteristic and spectacular spaces in the Royal Dockyards.


















2_MGrada Major




Botigues 5_Mail de la Generalitat

Floor area: 500 m^2





The Vestíbul is the Museum's entrance on its sea-facing side. Located on Passeig de Colom, at the end of the Rambles, it is a hypostyle hall with round arches and large windows that give prominence to a building that has been so important for the city.



7_MJardí del Baluard

The Jardí del Baluard is located on top of the only gate that has been conserved from Barcelona's mediaeval wall. A unique corner of the city that became incorporated into the monumental site of the Drassanes Reials i Museu Marítim de Barcelona.


